



**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT
FOR THE CONTROL OF HELIOTHIS AND LIGHTBROWN APPLE MOTH IN
WALNUTS**

PERMIT NUMBER - PER86671

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

DIPEL DF BIOLOGICAL INSECTICIDE DRY FLOWABLE (53431)
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: *BACILLUS THURINGIENSIS* SUBSP. KURSTAKI, STRAIN ABTS-351 as its only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Walnuts (all cultivars)	Heliothis, (<i>Helicoverpa spp.</i>) And Lightbrown Apple Moth (<i>Epiphyas postvittana</i>)	25-100 g/100L or 0.5-2.0 kg/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply as foliar spray by ground equipment. Ensure uniform, thorough coverage of all plant surfaces. Apply as a dilute spray application to the point of run-off. DO NOT spray past the point of run-off.
- Use sufficient water to ensure good coverage (1000 – 2000L/ha).
- Use a non-ionic surfactant at recommended rates.
- Apply a maximum of 4 applications per crop. Minimum re-treatment interval of 7 days.
- Crops must be monitored regularly for lepidopteran eggs or first star larvae. Time the commencement of spraying to coincide with egg hatch or first instar larvae activity and before damage to plants.
- Use in accordance with existing insecticide resistance management strategies and in accordance with best practice.

Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit as their *Control-of-Use* legislation means that an APVMA permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that state.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.
