"It works differently in different varieties so you need to be aware of that and over time know how to apply for each variety."

"I time the applications differently depending on what I'm trying to do. It depends on the different varieties and the weather at the time. So I usually talk to Frank Gallucio and go on his recommendations."



"Before you start you need have all your nutrients and water management up to speed otherwise you don't get the same results. To get the most of it you need to have everything else in place."
